REVISED INCENTIVE POLICY FOR EXTRA ORDINARY STUDENTS

Dated 2-1-2024.

The policy named "LTES INCENTIVE POLICY FOR EXTRA ORDINARY STUDENTS" to honour and encourage the extraordinary students of all domains from all the institutions run under banner of LTES framed in 2022 is hereby revised to widen the scope and to extend the incentives to more and more students. - Concession in fee shall be given in next class except for 12th students who will be provided concession in fee for current year for their standings in 11th std.
- Besides concession all candidates would be awarded one Merit Certificate along with medal each, one candidate would be eligible to claim only one incentive. Further, in case of tie of marks, the younger would be awarded for next rank.

A) Dr. APJ ABDUL KALAM OPEN SCHOLARSHIP

For 3rd to 10th Std. annually through written test to be held every year on **15th October**, the birth anniversary of Missile Man Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, the winners of scholarship are awarded as

The students can claim concession only for one category.

B) YOUNG SCIENTIST SCHOLARSHIP:

Students studying in classes VI to X can participate in a project-based competition (details given in description of scholarship) to be held every year on **28th February** in 2 groups (Gr-I-Grade VI-VIII and Gr-II Grade IX-X), One winner from each group will be selected as **Young Scientists** who will get 25% concession in Tuition fee in next session besides certification and a medal.

C) YOUNG WRITER SCHOLARSHIP:

Students studying in classes IX to XII can participate in a literary competition (details given in description of scholarship) to be held on **7th May** where one boy and one girl will be selected as **Young Writers** who will get 25% concession in Tuition fee in next session besides certification and a medal. (For class XII Std. award will be applicable for current session)

D) YOUNG MATHEMATICIAN SCHOLARSHIP:

Students studying in classes IV to X can participate in a Mental Maths competition (details given in description of scholarship) to be held every year **22nd December**, competition will be held in 2 groups (Gr-I-Grade IV-VIII and Gr-II Grade IX-X) where one Student securing maximum marks will be selected as **Young Mathematician** who will get 25% concession in Tuition fee in next session besides certification and a medal.

.E) YOUNG ARTIST SCHOLARSHIP:

Students studying in classes I to 12 can participate in an art competition to be held every year on **3rd October** in kind remembrance of great Indian Artist and Painter Raja Ravi Verma. The competition will be held in 4 groups (Gr-I-Grade I-II , Gr-II Grade III-V , Gr-III Grade VI-VIII and Gr-IV Grade IX-XII) , one student from each group will be selected as **Young Artist** and will get 10% concession in Tuition fee in next session besides certification and a medal.

F) BEST CALLIGRAPHY AWARD

Students studying in classes Nursery to 12 can participate in one or both languages English and Hindi calligraphy competition (details given in description of scholarship) to be held every year on **Second Wednesday of August** to mark **WORLD CALLIGRAPHY DAY** . The competition will be held in 5 groups (Gr-I Nursery to UKG, Gr-II-Grade I-II , Gr-III Grade III-V , Gr-IV Grade VI-VIII and Gr-V Grade IX-XII) , one student from each group for each language will be selected for Calligraphy

Award under which 10% concession in Tuition fee in next session besides certification and a medal will be provided.

G) **BEST SPEAKER AWARD**

Students of Grade -III to 12 can participate in Best Speaker Award (details given in description of scholarship) to be held every year on **12th January on the Birthday of the GREATEST THINKER OF MODERN ERA SWAMI VIVEKANAND**. The competition will be held in 3 groups (Gr-I Grade III-V , Gr-II Grade VI-VIII and Gr-III- Grade IX-XII) , one student from each group will be selected for Best Speaker Award under which 10% concession in Tuition fee in next session besides certification and a medal will be provided.

Note :- A student can participate in as many competitions as he wants and can win simultaneously more than one Scholarship / Award.

H) **YOUNG PROGRAMMER OF THE YEAR AWARD**

Students of Grade -III to 12 can participate individually or in group in **YOUNG PROGRAMMER OF THE YEAR AWARD** (details given in description of scholarship) to be held every year on **24th December**. Competition will be held in 3 groups (Gr-I Grade III-V , Gr-II Grade VI-VIII and Gr-III- Grade IX-XII), one student from each group will be selected for **YOUNG PROGRAMMER AWARD** under which 25% concession in Tuition fee in next session besides certification and a medal will be provided.

8. GLORIOUS AWARDS

A) **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT**

A student securing the first position in three classes consecutively will be awarded a cash price of the value of Rs. 11000 plus one Trophy and Certification.

AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP 25% REBATE IN TUITION FEE FOR NEXT YEAR .

PERIOD OF SCHOLARSHIP ONE YEAR ONLY

ELIGIBILITY Any student of KKCS from class 4th to 10th Std. who secured minimum 70% marks in Mathematics in the Annual examination of their previous class.

SYLLABUS Test for any class is based on the CBSE syllabi of mathematics of the previous classes.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. **YOUNG MATHEMATICIAN OF THE YEAR** scholarship will be awarded to one candidate from each group.
2. There will be a separate question paper for each class.
3. Questions based on subject aptitude (SAT), calculation ability (CAT) and mental ability (MAT) will be included in the question paper.
4. Medium of the question paper will be English only.
5. Question paper will contain 60 questions and the duration of the examination will be 90 minutes.
6. Question paper will have 40 objective type (multiple choices) and 5 descriptive questions only.
7. There will be 50% negative marking for objective type questions only.
8. Answer sheets will be provided to the candidates.
9. After the examination, the candidates would have to return both the Question booklet and the Answer sheet to the invigilator.
10. No candidate can ask to show the answer sheet of other candidate, however he /she can see his/her answer sheet only in presence of chairperson of evaluation committee by depositing a fee of Rs. 250/-
11. Entry fee or any other fee once paid will not be refunded/ adjusted what so ever the case be.

9. Please use only black/blue ink to write (Group-II to Group-V)
10. DO NOT make visible erasures cross-outs/cover- ups/whiting out; it will count more heavily against your work than the original errors themselves.
11. Entry fee once paid will not be refunded/ adjusted what so ever the case be.

 - **COMPETENCE** (the choice of layout and margins; spacing between letters, words, and lines; consistency of letter size and forms; accuracy of the quote; neatness and general appearance; spelling; and whether the participant strove to follow the letter and spirit of the Contest rules)

TOPICS

Each student will be given equal chance to show his / her skill in computer coding program.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ❖ The contest will be held every year on December 24 in the Computer / Robo Laboratory. Contestants should meet at 9:30 for a brief introductory talk. The contest proper will begin at 10.00 am - and end at 13.00 pm.
- ❖ Individuals or teams of up to three people will be allowed to compete. All contestants shall be student of KKCS from grade III to XIII .
- ❖ Contestants cannot bring any notes or textbooks to the contest room. Blank sheets of paper and pencils will be supplied.
- ❖ Contestants in the same team can discuss the problems they are assigned. However, they should do so in a quiet way and without disturbing contestants in other teams.
- ❖ Referees will be assigned to observe teams throughout the contest and report any problems and/or violations of the rules to the Contest Committee.
- ❖ Each team will be allowed to use only a single computer and must write and test their programs on that machine within the contest room and time slot.
- ❖ PC compatible computers running Window 7 or above will be used. At the Contest Committee's discretion, contestants may be allowed to use their own computer in the contest, provided that they notify the Contest Committee in writing at least one week prior to the contest, indicating the make and key features of their machine.
- ❖ Contestants may write their programs in whichever language they prefer. The following programming languages will be available. (a) Scratch Programming (b) Python (c) Java (d) Arduino C
- ❖ At the Contest Committee's discretion, contestants may be allowed to bring/use their own compiler (or interpreter) in the contest provided that they notify the Contest Committee in writing at least one week prior to the contest and indicate the make, version number and key features of their chosen compiler.

- ❖ Teams may submit only a single solution to each problem. All solutions must be submitted together on a single diskette. Both the source code and the executable program for each problem, must be included on the disk. Once submitted they may not be changed!
- ❖ Teams may not seek hints and/or ask for leads during the contest. They may, however, submit questions about procedure and/or clarification, in writing, to the Contest Committee who will ensure that all teams receive the same information as deemed necessary.
- ❖ All teams will be given the same set of problems to solve.
- ❖ Each problem will have a specified point value. The more difficult the problem, the more points a correct solution will receive.

EVALUATION AND RANKING

- ❖ Programs will be tested by two independent judges (appointed by the Contest Committee) by running them with a set of test inputs. The output for each test case will be marked as right or wrong using keys prepared before the contest.
- ❖ A program will be considered wrong if it fails to work on one or more of the test cases. It will otherwise be considered correct for the purposes of this contest. {A program may still be wrong even if it passes all the test input cases. Every effort will be made to design test cases that will minimize the chance of missing an incorrect program.} A correct program will be awarded the full points, an incorrect one zero! In the event of a tie, programs will be awarded partial credits based on the number of tests correctly passed.
- ❖ The Contest Committee will tally the scores for each team and publish a complete list. The teams with the four highest scores will be declared the winners and will be invited to take part in the trivia quiz round. The Contest Committee's decision in all matters is final.
- ❖ Contest Committee which comprises of
 - 1) Director LTES /KKCS
 - 2) Administrator LTES/ KKCSThey will appoint two senior most Computer / I.T. Staff from KKCS as independent judges who will award marks independently.
