ACADEMIC EVALUATION SYSTEM – 2026-27

Grade-NURSERY -VIII

The evaluation system for classes Nursery to VIII is divided into two terms with two major examinations namely Half Yearly Exam and Final Exam and two minor exams-one in each term named as Periodic Assessments-I and Periodic Assessment-II

PERIODIC ASSESSMENT (PA)

2-PERIODIC ASSESSMENTS namely **PA-I & PA-II** will be conducted in an academic year, one in each term,

PA for Grade Nur-UKG	PA-I and PA-II will be written tests of 20 marks each and will be conducted for main four subjects-English, Maths, Hindi and EVS. There will be no PA for Art and Craft.
PA for Grade I-VIII	PA-I and PA-II will be written tests of 40 marks each and will be conducted for all main subjects-English, Hindi, Math, Punjabi, EVS (5 subjects for Grade-I and II Only), Science and Social Sc. (6 subjects For Grade III-VIII). GK and Comp. Sc. will be assessed through 'Activity Based Questions' and are only grading subjects. There will be no PA for Art and Craft.

HALF YEARLY EXAMINATION (HYE) & ANNUAL EXAMINATION (AE)

HYE will be held at the end of Term 1 and **AE** will be held at the end of Term 2.

NURSERY -UKG	➤ HYE and AE will be of 30 Marks and will be conducted for all main four subjects (English, Math, Hindi and EVS). ➤ HYE as well as AE will be conducted for Art /Craft also but no marks will be added in result and only grades will be awarded. ➤ HYE will be taken from entire syllabus of Term-I and similarly AE will be taken from entire syllabus of Term-II only. ➤ Result compilation will be as per Annexure-III
GRADE-I-II	➤ HYE and AE for Grades I and II will be of 80 Marks. HYE and AE will be conducted for all main five subjects (English, Math, EVS, Punjabi & Hindi). ➤ HYE as well as AE will also be conducted for GK. Computer Sc. and Art /Craft also but no marks will be added in result and only grades will be awarded for these subjects. ➤ HYE will be taken from entire syllabus of Term-I and similarly AE will be taken from entire syllabus of Term-II only. ➤ Result compilation will be as per Annexure-III
GRADE-III-VIII	➤ HYE and AE for Grades III and VIII will be of 70 Marks. HYE and AE will be conducted for all main six subjects (English, Math, Science, Social Science, Punjabi & Hindi). ➤ HYE as well as AE will be conducted for GK. Computer Sc. and Art /Craft also but no marks will be added in result and only grades will be awarded for these subjects. ➤ HYE will be taken from entire syllabus of Term-I and similarly AE will be taken from entire syllabus of Term-II only. ➤ Result compilation will be as per Annexure-III

ACADEMIC EVALUATION SYSTEM – 2026-27

Grade-IX -XII

The evaluation system for classes IX to XI is based on annual system with one major exam namely Final Exam at the end of year besides three minor exams named as Periodic Assessments-I, Periodic Assessment-II and Periodic Assessment-III. Best 2 Periodic Tests out of three will be taken for evaluation purpose.

The evaluation system for classes X and XII at school level is just to monitor the progress of a student and for awarding internal marks where ever applicable. To monitor the progress throughout the year 4 written tests are conducted namely PA-I, PA-II, PA-III and Pre board Exam. No report card is issued for Grade X and XII Students.

PERIODIC ASSESSMENT (PA)

For Grade IX to XII, 3- **PERIODIC ASSESSMENTS** namely **PA-I, PA-II** and **PA-III** will be conducted in an academic year.

Grade IX - XII	❖ 2 PA, PA-I and PA-III will be written tests of 20 marks each, whereas PA-II will be taken for 80 marks. Best 2 of three will be considered for evaluation. ❖ PA will be conducted for all subjects.

ANNUAL EXAMINATION

Annual Examination (AE) will be held at the end of the year for IX and XI in the month of March, while for Grade -X and XII, Pre Board exam will be conducted before CBSE final exams.

Grade- IX and XI	❖ Final exam will be conducted for all subjects for the marks as per assessment pattern given in Annexure-III
Grade- X and XII	❖ Final exam will be conducted for all subjects by CBSE for the marks as per assessment pattern given in Annexure-III

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (IA)

No Internal Assessment is proposed for classes Nursery to UKG, however besides written test due weightage will be given to Speaking, Listening, Understanding & Application Skills tested through oral / class tests and a comprehensive result for each term and then taking average of each term, a final result will be prepared.

Internal Assessment is designed for classes I to X, which provides a continuous and comprehensive report on the student's performance through various academic activities such as Periodic Assessments, other Multiple Assessments, Portfolio and Subject Enrichment Activities as per **ANNEXURE-1**

1. TAGORE TROPHY - (LITERATURE TROPHY)

The school authorities have decided to set up a running trophy named as **TAGORE TROPHY** in the honour of celebration of birthday of **Rabindranath Tagore**, on his birth anniversary ie **May 7** for his excellence in the field of literature. **Rabindranath Tagore** was a Bengali poet, short-story writer, **song** composer, playwright, essayist, and painter who introduced new prose and verse forms and the use of **colloquial** language into **Bengali literature**, thereby freeing it from traditional models based on classical **Sanskrit**. He was highly influential in introducing Indian **culture** to the West and vice versa, and he is generally regarded as the outstanding creative artist of early 20th-century. In 1913 he became the first non-European to receive the **Nobel Prize for Literature**. The trophy would be presented to the winning house of **INTER HOUSE LITERATURE QUIZ** to be hosted every year on this day. The Quiz will be held in 4 segments as under :-

4. C V RAMAN TROPHY (SCIENCE TROPHY)

The school authorities have decided to establish a running trophy named as **C.V. RAMAN TROPHY** to be presented to the winning house of **Inter House Science Quiz** to be hosted every year on the occasion of **National Science Day i.e. 28th February**. On this day in 1928, Sir CV Raman discovered the phenomenon of scattering of photons which was later known as '**Raman Effect**' after his name. After two years in 1930, he got Nobel Prize for this remarkable discovery and this was the first Nobel Prize for India in the field of Science.

In 1986, the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC) asked the Government of India to designate 28 February as National Science Day which the then Govt. of India accepted and declared the day as National Science Day in 1986. The first National Science Day was celebrated on February 28, 1987. Henceforth,

every year, KKCS will also celebrate the **NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY** by presenting a running trophy CV RAMAN TROPHY in the name of Sir CV Raman. The Quiz will be held in 4 segments as under :-
